Table Availability: First-Come-First-Served Basis!

The *fee for one person with one professional badge is \$35.00 (One 6-8 ft Table / One Chair); the fee for two people with two professional badges is \$50.00 (One 6-8 ft Table / Two Chairs). [*Fees for large booth and corporate displays are negotiable.] **ON-SITE REGISTRATION IS NOT GUARANTEED.** There are **limited** electric outlets available so **ask in advance.** Small easels are permitted and banners can be hung from the front of your table if they do not interfere with the professional on either side of you. If you would like to be placed next to another professional who has purchased a table, please indicate the name on your registration form and we will do our best to accommodate your request.

The **KIDS' COMIC CON** is **STRICTLY AN ALL AGE/FAMILY-oriented** show. Comics and magazines containing *extreme violence, vulgarity, nudity, and/or gore* are **NOT PERMITTED.** If at anytime you are asked by Convention Management to cover and or remove an item from the view of our younger attendees, you must do so immediately, or you will be asked to leave the show room floor. If asked to leave you will not receive a refund.

Please note: We expect you to be set at least 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the Convention. The Marketplace hours are 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
